Our stock levels are the lowest they have been since we opened our doors 13 years ago! If you can donate any food or hygiene items PLEASE, pop them in our trolleys or come on down and bring them to us. If you are a little flush; you can do online shopping with ASDA as they will deliver to us on your behalf. Please drop into the building as we now do a breakfast for the homeless so eggs are always needed plus cheese, butter bacon etc as we have a fridge freezer, freezer and fridge. Fruit and vegetables are always welcome but do not put in a trolley.

<u>THANKS</u>: Huge thanks to all of the churches and schools that have collected Harvest donations for us; it has been wonderful to have so much fresh produce to give out.

<u>UPDATE</u>: So far this year we have cooked 729 breakfasts 551 lunches and fed 4,052 through the Storehouse. Please continue to donate to us so we can keep blessing the people of Trowbridge. Thank you all.
